

Directions to 1740 Ridge Ave. & Instructions for Entering the Building

By CTA or Metra

- Take the Purple Line/Evanston Express or the Metra Union Pacific District North Line and get off at the Davis Street Evanston stop.
- Walk west on Davis or Church.
- Cross to the west side of Ridge.
- Turn right (north) to 1740 Ridge. It's about a 5-block walk.

By Car

- The only legal entrance is from southbound Green Bay Road which turns into Ridge Ave. You cannot cross Ridge if you are northbound.
- Enter the driveway where there is a large white sign that says 1800. Do not park on that side.
- Drive behind the building and around to the other side. You may park anywhere on that side, even if there is no Visitor Parking sign.
- This second driveway is an exit only. Do not enter there.

From the North

- Take Green Bay Road southbound
- Just after the merge between Ridge and Green Bay, bear right into the parking lot at 1740 Ridge. You will enter just in front of the large white sign that says 1800.
- If you miss it, turn right at the first opportunity (Davis) Then turn right on Asbury, and again right on Emerson, and again right on Green Bay. Try again.

From the West

- Take Golf eastbound
- Where Golf crosses McCormick, keep going straight as Golf becomes Emerson
- Turn right on Green Bay Road
- Bear right into the parking lot at 1740 Ridge at the white sign that says 1800.
- If you miss it, turn right at the first opportunity (Davis). Then turn right on Asbury, and again right on Emerson, and again right on Green Bay. Try again.

From the South

- Take Ridge northbound
- At Davis turn left (you can't legally get to our parking lot from northbound Ridge)
- Turn right on Asbury
- Turn right on Emerson
- Turn right on Green Bay Road
- Bear right into the parking lot at 1740 Ridge
- If you miss it, turn right at the first opportunity (Davis). Then turn right on Asbury, and again right on Emerson, and again right on Green Bay. Try again

ENTRANCE

You may enter through the front door of the 1740 building.

When we speak, I will provide you with the current code for the front door.

You must use the SMALL keypad only.

Punch the code into the keypad and walk over to the door. There will be no sound, so just pull it open.it

At times the door is temperamental. Try it again or contact me through the directory.

WAITING AREA

Please walk up the stairs or take the elevator to the second floor. At the top of the landing, you will see several chairs and a table. Please have a seat there and I will come out to greet you for your appointment. I do not have a private waiting area in Suite 212. I ask that you do not knock, as I may be in session when you arrive. The area at the top of the stairs is a shared waiting area for many of the offices on the second floor.

If you arrive late, after your scheduled appointment time, please know that I leave my office door open for you. You are welcome to walk to the office, rather than wait, as I would not want to miss you, not knowing you were sitting there. But, this is only if you arrive after your scheduled time.
